

GRAHAM CLARK 3.9 MILE MEMORIAL RACE

RACE INFORMATION

RACE DATE / VENUE

The Graham Clark 3.9 Mile Memorial Race is organised by Carnegie Harriers Running Club in memory of former Club Coach Graham Clark. The race will take place at 7.45pm* on Tuesday 7th August 2012. It takes place at Knockhill Racing Circuit by Dunfermline and involves three full laps of Knockhill Racing Circuit.

* Race start time subject to minor alteration depending on commercial bookings of the track

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for pre-race entries is £5.00 for SAL members and £7.00 for Non-SAL members. Online race entry is available through EntryCentral. Race numbers must be collected on the night between 6pm and 7.45pm. Entries will be accepted on the night between 6pm – 7.30pm if the race limit is not reached. The on the night entry fee is £7.00 for SAL members and £9.00 for Non-SAL members. Runners are encouraged to pre-enter this event if possible.

RACE LIMIT

There is a race limit of 250 runners for this event and no further race entries will be accepted if the race limit is reached.

PARKING

There is ample parking available within the grounds of Knockhill Racing Circuit.

CHANGING FACILITIES

Changing facilities are available at Knockhill Racing Circuit but we recommend that you come along ready to run. The organisers accept no responsibility for loss of clothing or equipment.

REFRESHMENTS

A free buffet, teas and coffees will be available after the race.

CHARITY

£1.00 from every race entry will be donated to a charity selected by Carnegie Harriers.

RACE PRIZES

Individual awards will be presented to the 1st three men, 1st three ladies, 1st M40, 1st F40, 1st M50, 1st F50, 1st M60, 1st F60, 1st M70, 1st MJ (U20), 1st FJ (U20). A number of spot prizes will be awarded in addition.
